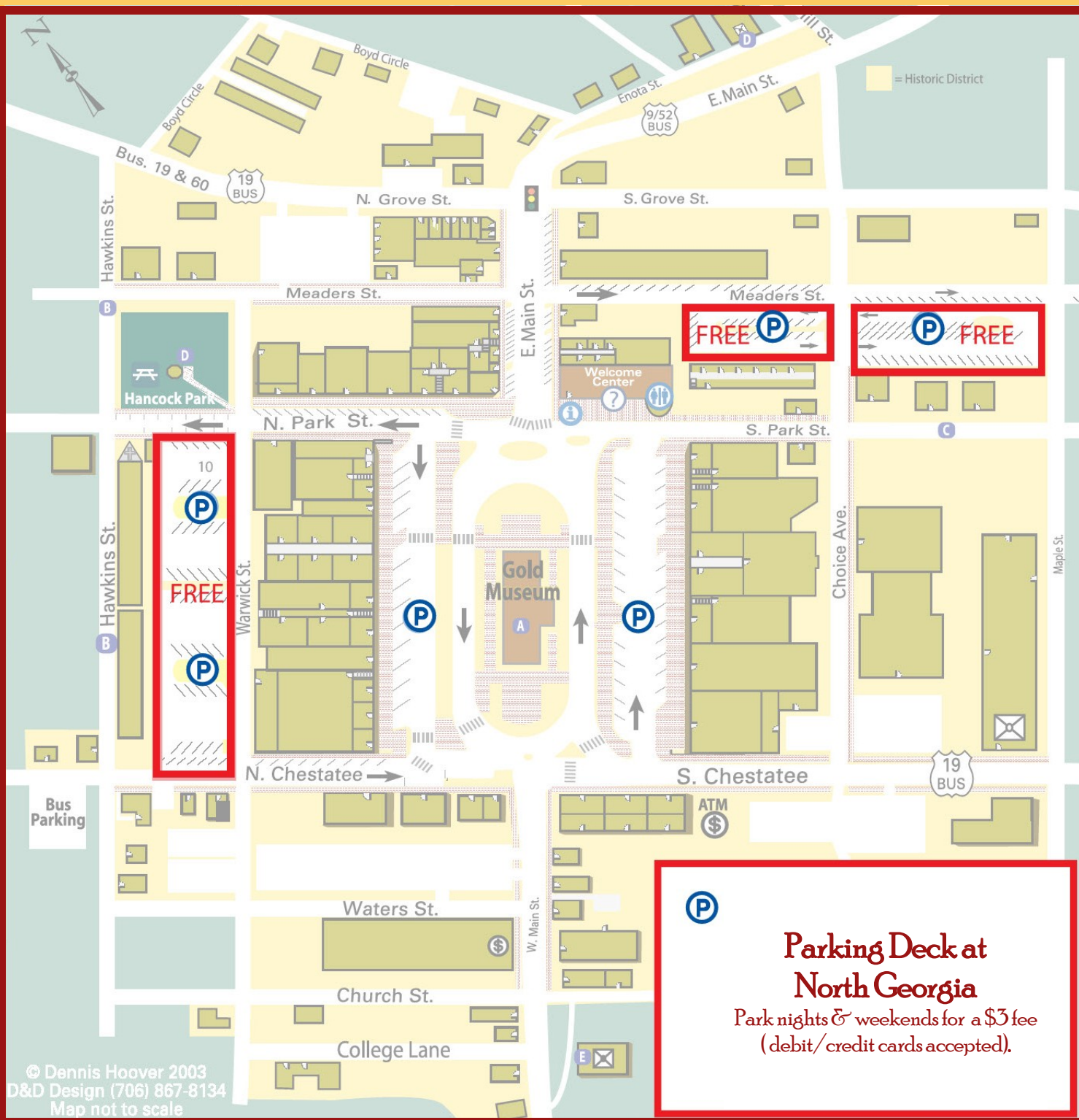

Business Customers have parking options available for shopping, dining, and playing in downtown Dahlonega. If the 275 convenient street spaces in the downtown are filled at peak hours, always remember that Dahlonega maintains **three** free parking lots with easy access to all downtown businesses.

- ★ Two parking lots at the intersection of Meaders Street and Choice Street are conveniently located near the Dahlonega Welcome Center.
- ★ A third parking lot is located on Warwick Street between North Chestatee and North Park Streets (perfect for Hancock Park events!).
- ★ Another great option is the parking deck at North Georgia College & State University available from 5:30 PM - 7:30 AM, Monday - Thursday, and weekends starting Friday at 5:30 PM to Monday at 7:30 AM. For a small fee (payable with debit or credit cards), enjoy this shady and convenient parking deck option.
