The City Code Enforcement Officer will ensure permit holders comply with ordinances and regulations. Any violations may result in immediate and permanent revocation of the vendor's permit.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: Please read and initial beside each item.

_____ 1. The 2022 Farmers Market will be open for our farmers and customers every Saturday, May 7th through October 8th, 2022. **Saturday hours are 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Tuesday hours are 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. Vendors are not authorized to sell items prior to market officially opening.**

_____ 2. **Only agricultural items grown or produced in the state of Georgia**

_____ 3. Individuals desiring to produce and offer for sale any sort of packaged food (canned goods, baked goods, jams, jellies, etc.) must be a Cottage Food Operator, and prior to manufacturing Cottage Food Products, the Cottage Food Operator must register with the Georgia Department of Agriculture's Food Safety Division. All packaged Cottage Food Products must be properly labeled with the maker/seller's name and contact information (address and/or phone number), as well as, with the following statement conspicuously labeled on the package, "MADE IN A COTTAGE FOOD OPERATION THAT IS NOT SUBJECT TO STATE FOOD SAFETY INSPECTIONS." ALL ingredients must be listed on the label. This is specified by the Georgia Department of Agriculture. *It is the vendor's responsibility to determine if additional licenses are required by the Georgia Department of Agriculture for certain packaged foods in order to be in compliance with the state's "Food Processing Safety" Guidelines.*

_____ 4. Individuals desiring to produce and offer for sale eggs shall have an Egg Candling certificate from The Georgia Department of Agriculture. The eggs must be stored in an ice chest with cool packs and be properly labeled.

_____ 5. Individuals desiring to produce and offer for sale meat products must have processed the product in a USDA licensed facility. The product must bear the USDA legend and be properly labeled. The vendor must also have a Mobile Meat license, mechanical refrigerated holding unit and a certified scale at the point of sale.

_____ 6. Individuals desiring to produce and offer for sale dairy products must have a Food Sales Establishment License coded as a 430 - Grade A Milk Plant through the Georgia Department of Agriculture.

_____ 7. Farmers may bring their own table and/or tent. Each farmer will be allotted 10 feet x 10 feet of space for each permit issued. *Farmers are only allowed to set up in the mulched areas of Hancock Park along the sidewalks of Warwick St, Park St, Hawkins St and Meaders St. It is possible to set up underneath the Hancock Park pavilion on Saturdays by prior arrangements with Main Street Staff.*

_____ 8. Farmers will be allowed to sell from a truck no larger than 3/4 ton size by special arrangements only. *Refer to first page to list dates a truck space is being requested.*

_____ 9. Farmers must display a copy of their current Dahlonega Farmers Market permit (and state licenses as applicable) at their sales table/area at all times. *(For your privacy, you may mark through your phone number and email address if you choose.)*
